Marching to the Beat of Membership – Tracy Kinnick Department VP

Whew...what an amazing Fall Conference. Thank you to everyone who spent time at the membership table. Everyone had great questions during the conference that I want to share with all of our department.

- 1. Why do I not have access to ALAMIS?
 - a. There are a few reasons why you do not have access, if your unit did not submit your name, and pay for ALAMIS access you will not have access. If you applied/ asked for FULL Access, you may need to complete your



required training before you have access. If you need to pay for access or double-check your names, you can call me to see who has access or reach out to Carol at the Department office.

- 2. My unit membership due's did not change.
 - a. Membership dues increased Nationally as well as for our Department for the 2024 year, if your unit did not submit a change form, your membership dues did not go up. You can still change your rates, there is a \$30.00 charge for this change, however keep in mind that renewal notices are currently going out and your current rate listed in ALAMIS is what will be on those renewals. If you want to know your unit rates, do not hesitate to call, I have that information readily available to answer for you.

These two questions were the most asked questions during the fall conference.

What are we up to? We are hosting monthly Zoom calls with district presidents and vice presidents to discuss membership, ask questions, and share success stories.
